

# A 3-STEP, PRESUPPOSITIONAL APPROACH TO APOLOGETICS



## I'll admit that...

...presuppositional apologetics can be hard to grasp at first. However, when it *clicks*, it can be a powerful, biblical and versatile way to defend your Christian worldview. I have found this three-step approach to be very useful.

01

## Show the problem with the unbiblical position.

Ask questions to uncover the inconsistency. Reveal that inconsistency and how it makes the position false (do a *reductio ad absurdum*).

*Example: "God is immoral?" By what standard? Without God, what is your basis for "rules" of morality?*



## Show how the Bible solves the problem.

Explain how the Bible gives the foundation for the very categories needed for the objection to make sense. You may also show why the objection is unfounded.

*Example: God is the standard for morality. Now here's why what God did was right....*

## Show how Jesus solves the ultimate problem.

Lead the conversation to the Gospel.  
*Example: The same Bible also says "the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."*
